

2012 Kentucky Baptist All State Children's Choirs General Information

Registration:

Once invited, returning and new members are responsible for their own registration. (Check with your Minister of Music before registering, some churches prefer to register together.) Registration is handled via the Internet and will require a \$25 deposit. A link to register is included in your letter.

Cost:

\$160 for singers; \$125 for chaperones

Fee includes, lodging, meals, linens for all, (also a programming fee/shirt for the singers.)

On-line registration must be completed and \$25 deposit paid by **February 14** (returning singers) and **March 13** (new singers). Payment in full is due by **April 6**. (**All Chaperones must be registered by April 6**). *(Each church is responsible for sending their own chaperones, one for every five singers of the same gender)*

Medical Release Form:

There are two medical release forms required for participation. One form is required for Crossings Camps and the other for the Kentucky Baptist Convention. Links to both forms will be sent with registration confirmation. Both forms **MUST BE NOTARIZED**.

Snacks:

Participants should bring their own snacks. Drink machines are available, but you are also welcome to bring your own.

Music:

Folders for each singer will be sent to the Minister of Music/Contact person for each church. He/she will also receive copies of all the music to keep, along with a rehearsal CD to duplicate for each singer. The Minister of Music/Contact Person should practice several times with their singers, and the singers should practice daily on their own.

Electronic Media:

Singers do not need computers, mp3 players, I-pods, game boys, etc. Please leave these devices at home. There is very little free time during the weekend and we want the singers to have some time to fellowship together and rest. Cell phones are not allowed in rehearsals. If parents feel singers must bring a cell phone with them for the weekend, the phone should be given to his/her chaperone except when needed to call home. (Chaperones may bring these items for their personal use, but please do not "pass them on" to the singers.)

Concert Dress:

Green logo t-shirts will be provided for the singers. (Chaperones may choose to purchase them when they register by **April 6** for \$12). Black SLACKS with dark socks and dark shoes **MUST BE** worn with the shirt for concerts.

Please do not wear leggings, stretch pants, "hip huggers," sweat pants, crop pants, Capri pants or jeans. No open-toed shoes, please. Shirts will be worn tucked in with no other shirts under them.
